## **OPTION TO STUDY SPANISH AS SECOND LANGUAGE:**

10 intensive course levels.

Each course: 4 weeks (one month), 4 hours per day.

### **1. INTENSIVE COURSES**

The intensive Spanish courses offered by the International Language Center consist of 80 hours per level.

Ten levels are offered and each one is organized into two blocks; during the first two hours of each day the student will understand about grammatical structures and its functioning into the language. During the last two hours, the class focuses on using the new learned structures and apply them in contexts similar to everyday situations; the students will also practice with vocabulary programmed to achieve gradual progress in the management of spanish as a second language.

Two teachers are in charge of each level during the four weeks. This allows the student to be in contact with different ways of expressing and interacting, as well as with different characters and personalities; such as in the real life.
