

CCIS is pleased to introduce the professional development grant for the 28th Annual CCIS Conference: Creating Sustainability in Education Abroad.

Funded by CCIS Program Sponsors, the grants were established to facilitate and foster engagement and dialogue within our international education community. They allow for education abroad professionals and faculty to learn about the CCIS consortium model and its education abroad programs.

Five grants are available for first-time conference attendees from US colleges and universities. Recipients will receive a \$500 travel stipend and waived registration fees. We encourage members, non-members, and faculty to apply.

Applications are due by September 15, 2017.

Submit an application online including a 400-word personal statement detailing how attending the conference would benefit education abroad at your institution and why you would like to be considered for the professional grant. Consider the conference focus of creating sustainability in education abroad.
